Characters:

Jingle: A cheerful, slightly clumsy elf.

Tinsel: A sassy, confident elf.

Sprinkle: A nervous elf who worries about everything.

Blitzen: The wise-cracking elf who tries to keep everyone calm.

Setting:

A colorful locker room filled with tiny elf-sized lockers, Christmas decorations, and a big mirror. Elves are getting ready for their big night delivering presents.

Scene 1: The Locker Room

(The stage is set with elves bustling around. Jingle is struggling to fit into his red coat.)

Jingle: (pulling at his coat) Why do we always have to wear these tiny coats? I feel like a candy cane that's been left out in the sun!

Tinsel: (adjusting her sparkly hat) At least you're not wearing last year's model! I'm pretty sure this hat is still stuck in a snowstorm!

(Sprinkle enters, looking frazzled.)

Sprinkle: Guys! What if Santa forgets to put us on the nice list this year? What if we don't get any cookies?

Blitzen: (rolling his eyes) Relax, Sprinkle! Santa loves us. Besides, he needs us to help him deliver gifts. Who else would he trust with all those toys? The reindeer?

(Everyone laughs.)

Scene 2: Pre-Flight Jitters

(Jingle accidentally knocks over a stack of toy boxes.)

Jingle: Oops! Sorry! I guess I'm just practicing my "elf-tumbling" skills!

Tinsel: (laughing) You might want to practice your “not knocking things over” skills instead!

(Sprinkle starts pacing back and forth.)

Sprinkle: What if the sleigh breaks down? What if we get lost? What if we run out of hot cocoa?

Blitzen: (smirking) If we run out of hot cocoa, we’ll just have to use our magic to make more!

(He pretends to wave a wand.)

Blitzen: Abracadabra! Hot cocoa, come to me!

(Everyone giggles as Jingle pretends to sip an imaginary cup.)

Scene 3: The Final Countdown

(The elves gather around a large clock counting down to midnight.)

Tinsel: Okay, team! We’ve got ten minutes until takeoff! Who’s ready?

Jingle: (raising his hand) Me! But first, can someone help me with my belt? It keeps slipping!

(Tinsel rolls her eyes and helps Jingle adjust his belt.)

Sprinkle: (still nervous) What if the reindeer don’t want to fly? They can be pretty stubborn!

Blitzen: (grinning) Then we’ll just tell them it’s for the kids! You know how much they love cookies and milk!

(The elves cheer and high-five each other.)

Scene 4: The Big Moment

(The clock strikes midnight. Everyone freezes in excitement.)

Tinsel: It’s time! Let’s go spread some holiday cheer!

(They all rush towards the exit but Jingle gets stuck in the door.)

Jingle: (waving his arms) A little help here?!

(Tinsel and Blitzen pull him through just as Sprinkle holds up a giant cookie.)

Sprinkle: Wait! Before we go, cookie break?

(Everyone stops, looks at the cookie, then at each other.)

All Elves Together: COOKIE BREAK!!!

(They all dive for the cookie as the lights dim and festive music plays.)
